

## DISTRICT 12 CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

1. The ACBL General Conditions of Contest and Guidelines for Sectional Tournaments at Clubs will control, except as expressly amended by these District Conditions or by the Director in Charge's ruling.
2. The ACBL General Convention Chart will apply in all flights. No local exceptions to the GCC may be granted for this competition.
3. All events shall be conducted as single-session Stratified Pairs events. Strata are: A (1501+); B (501 - 1500); C (< 500). Pairs shall be stratified according to the higher masterpoint holding of the pair's individuals as of the ACBL masterpoint cycle most recently published prior to the contest.
4. No session will be held without a minimum number of club games being contested on any day and time in the DIC's discretion. Games may be held in the afternoon or evening. Classification will follow the ACBL Conditions of Contest. Requests to change a game's classification, including the reason for change, must be submitted to the Director in Charge *in writing* at least thirty (30) days before the date of the event, and any changes will rest in the DIC's sole discretion.
5. Games scheduled for an *afternoon* session may not begin before 11:00 a.m. Games scheduled for an evening session may not begin before 6:30 p.m. M-S or 5:00 p.m. Sunday.
6. Results must be reported to the DIC prior to the start of the next scheduled STAC session. Results for afternoon games must be reported by 7 p.m. the same day as the game, and evening results must be reported before noon the day following the game.
