

2025-2026 GNT Conditions of Contest for District 12

The 2025-2026 Grand National Teams Final will be held Sunday April 19, 2026, at The Bridge Connection 26776 W. 12 Mile Rd in Southfield, Michigan. Play will begin at 11:00 am There is no club or unit qualifying required. Teams may directly enter the District Finals and are encouraged to do so.

The masterpoint range for each flight is as follows:

Unlimited-No Masterpoint limit; Flight A-0-6000; Flight B- 0-3000; Flight C-0-750
NON-LIFE MASTER.

Masterpoints as of the August 2025 Cycle. This event is not averaged. Both the ACBL Conditions of Contest for the GNT and the District Conditions of Contest are on the District Website. www.district12bridge.org.

Teams may consist of 4 to 6 players. Each player must be a resident of District 12 and be a member in good standing of the ACBL at all stages of the competition. Detailed information about residency requirements is in the ACBL Conditions of Contest along with information about exceptions. A condition of entry in this event is that a team which wins its flight agrees to represent the District in the ACBL GNT Final at the Summer NABC in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Sanctions regarding future District events may occur if a winning team does not represent the District at the NABC. The winning team receives a stipend from the District to help defray the cost of attending the NABC. At least three of the original Team members must play, and you can augment up to 6 players from your District.

A one day two session swiss or round robin format will be used, and we will have no fewer than 24 boards in any flight with a maximum of 30 boards.
