Sunday lunch between team sessions is still only \$10.

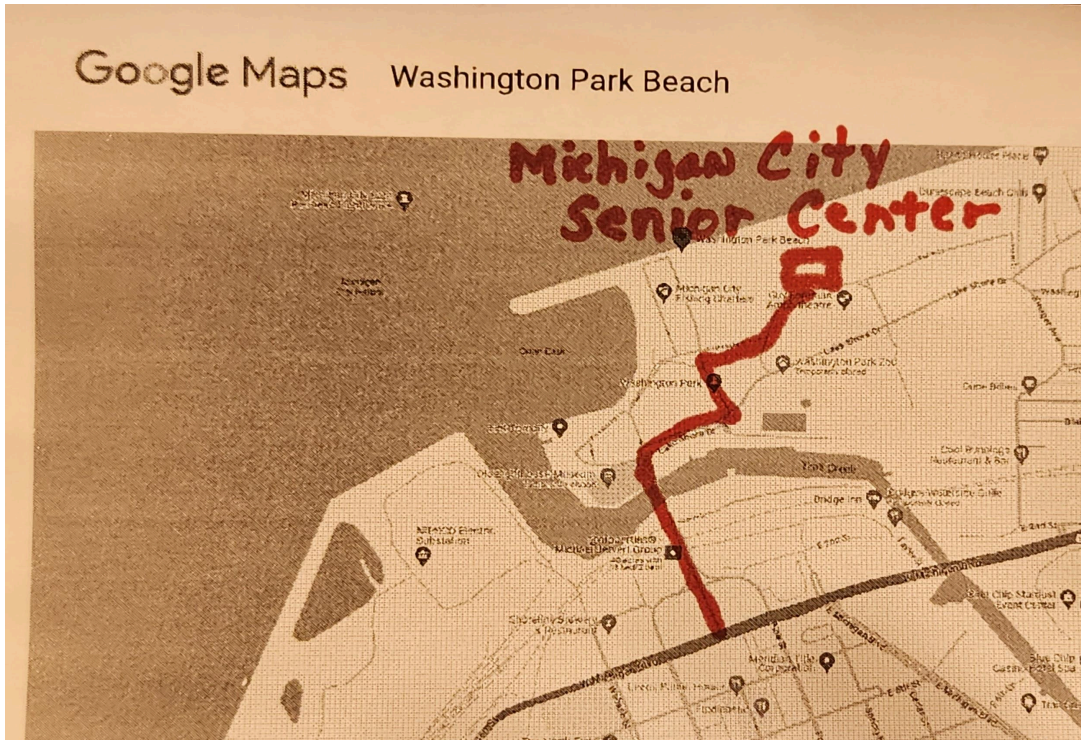

Directions:

From Michigan: I-94 W to US-12 W in New Buffalo.

From South Bend: US-20 W to US-12 W in Michigan City.

From Fort Wayne: US-30 W to US-35 N and then west on US-20 to US-12 W.

From NWI and Chicago: I-94 E to US-20 E (exit 22B) and continue east for 10 miles to US-12 E.

From US 12 (Michigan Blvd) head north to the Franklin St bridge over Trail Creek. Continue east on Lake Shore Drive for about 500 feet and turn left on the first road, which is the entrance to Washington Park. Once within the park, turn right at the first stop sign and then turn left at the next stop sign. The Michigan City Senior Center is on the left after the curve in the road.
